**HSBC SHEUNG SHUI CENTRE PREMIER CENTRE
TEMPORARILY CLOSED FOR 14 DAYS**

HSBC Sheung Shui Centre Premier Centre (Shop 1024-1028 & 1030-1031, Level 1, Sheung Shui Centre, Sheung Shui, New Territories) is closed temporarily for 14 days from today as a staff member has been preliminarily tested positive for COVID-19 on 24 July. The concerned staff member had been working from home since 17 July and returned to the branch on 22 to 23 July. The individual's main duty involves handling general customer enquiries in the bank hall, and close contact with customers is limited. All staff at the branch are confirmed to have been wearing masks while on duty and have their temperature taken on a daily basis, as required by the Bank.

Deep cleaning and disinfection has been arranged at the branch and all other staff members will be on self-quarantine for at least 14 days at home. As a precaution, the Bank will arrange all employees at that branch to have virus testing. The Bank is offering full support and assistance for its staff members.

The health of its employees and customers is the bank's top priority. To better protect employees and visitors, temperature screening has been implemented at all the branches, all individuals are required to put on a mask during their visit at the bank's premises. Hand sanitiser is also available in all branches for use, if needed.
