The phishing email also suggests receipents to click a link that goes to a fraudulent website: https:/helaloa-buda-colk12if.blogspot.com

We would like to remind customers that the Bank has no connection with the phishing email and fraudulent website involved, which was sent through a non-HSBC email address. Customers should disregard this email and avoid disclosing any personal information or clicking any link in the email.
