HSBC Dragon Centre Day & Night Plus¹ (Unit 601D, Level 6, Dragon Centre, 37K Yen Chow Street, Sham Shui Po, Kowloon) will be closed from 29 January until further notice, while service hours at the adjacent Express Banking remain unchanged.

This is a precautionary measure for contingency purposes to safeguard the health and safety of the Bank's customers and employees in light of the rapidly evolving COVID-19 situation in Hong Kong, while balancing the need to ensure normal banking services to the community.
