HSBC Centre Branch (Shop E, UG/F, Tower 1, HSBC Centre, 1 Sham Mong Road, Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon) will be closed from 18 March until further notice as a customer who visited the branch on 12 March was tested COVID-19 positive.

Deep cleaning and disinfection has been arranged at the branch. As a precaution, the Bank has requested all employees at that branch to have virus testing and will provide them with all necessary assistance.

With the health and safety of customers and employees in mind, precautionary hygiene and safety measures, such as wearing masks, preentry temperature screening, hand-sanitisers, spaced queuing and portable acrylic screens at open banking counters, will continue to be in place across the Bank's branch network.
