HSBC MAIN BUILDING REOPENS

HSBC Main Building (One Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong), including branches on BL1, L3, L5 & L6, will re-open on Monday, 22 March 2021.

The Bank's first priority is the health and safety of customers and employees. It voluntarily closed HSBC Main Building last week for deep cleaning and disinfection after a compulsory testing notice was published on 16 March.

Across the Bank's offices and branch network, precautionary measures, such as wearing masks, pre-entry temperature screening, hand-sanitisers, spaced queuing and portable acrylic screens at open banking counters, will continue to be in place.

Customers can also turn to the Bank's digital channels - mobile banking, internet banking, phone banking or self-service banking terminals - to do their banking.

Contingency arrangements, including work from home and split-site operation, will continue at HSBC to ensure business continuity. HSBC will continue to monitor the situation and take appropriate measures to ensure the health and safety of its employees and customers.
