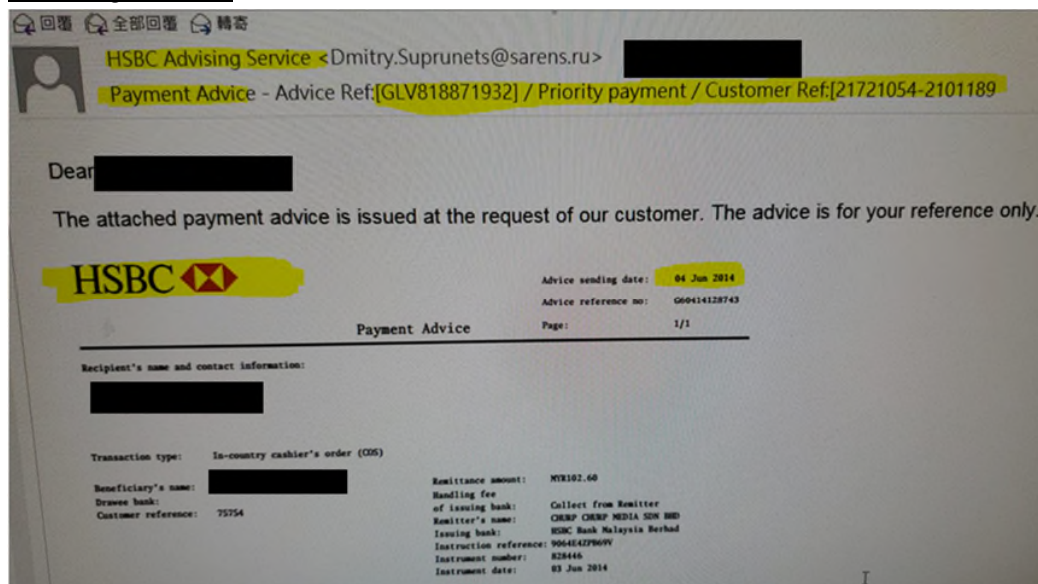
HSBC WARNS AGAINST PHISHING EMAILS

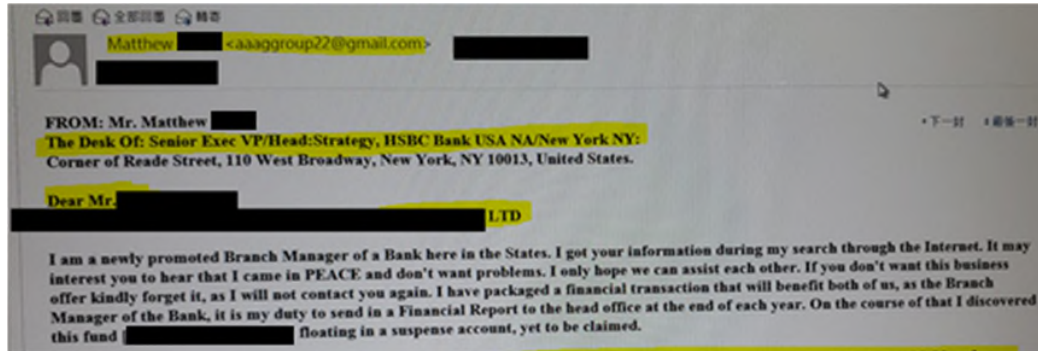
HSBC would like to remind its customers that it has no connection with the phishing emails involved. Customers are advised not to open any attachment in the emails.
