HSBC WARNS AGAINST PHISHING EMAILS AND FRAUDULENT WEBSITES

The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited would like to alert its customers to phishing emails and fraudulent websites purported to be from HSBC PayMe. The phishing emails suggest that recipients can claim a gift by opening a link.


HSBC would like to remind its customers that it has no connection with the phishing emails and the fraudulent websites involved. Customers are advised not to open any link in the email.


The public should also safe-keep their login credentials. HSBC reiterate that it will not send SMS or email messages with embedded hyperlinks directing customers to its websites or mobile applications to carry out transactions, or request for sensitive personal information or credit card details from customers through hyperlinks.
