HSBC WARNS AGAINST PHISHING WEBSITE

The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited would like to alert its customers to a phishing website purported to be from HSBC. The phishing website suggest customers to enter their bank account number and password to login.

HSBC would like to remind its customers that it has no connection with the phishing website involved. Customers are advised not to enter any bank account information in the website. The public should also safe-keep their login credentials. HSBC reiterated that it will not send SMS or email messages with embedded hyperlinks directing customers to its websites or mobile applications to carry out transactions, or request for sensitive personal information or credit card details from customers through hyperlinks.
