Over 7,200 Students Granted HSBC Scholarships Since 1965

Marina TONG, Chief Operating Officer, Hong Kong, HSBC, and a former recipient of the HSBC Overseas Scholarship participated in a panel discussion with HSBC Scholars alumni.
